Fayette Elementary School will:

 - *To provide homework assignments that reinforce classroom instruction
- 2. Hold parent conference day and discuss this compact as it relates to a students' individual achievement. Parent conference day will be held in October.**
 - *Teachers will be available daily during their planning time for conferences
 - *Teachers will be available to phone conference if needed
- 3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their child's progress. Specifically, the school will provide report cards at the end of every six weeks grading period.**
 - * Graded papers will be returned every Tuesday in red folders
 - * Progress reports will be sent home
 - *Teachers will keep their Inow account up-to-date
- 4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents by appointment before and after school or during the teacher's planning times.**
 - *Teachers may be contacted by phone calls
 - *Teachers may be contacted by written note in red folders or daily folders
 - *Teachers may be contacted by email
- 5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and to observe classroom activities. Specifically, parents are encouraged to participate, or volunteer in the child's classroom.**
 - * Parent are invited on field trips, to do art projects, and extra-curricular school activities
 - * Parents can also volunteer at book fairs and read to their child's classroom
- 6. Provide meaningful communication between family members and school staff in a language family members can understand.**
 - * Documents will be translated as needed to accommodate parents that speak other languages
 - * All notes and forms will be sent home in the family's primary language
